#### **Irish Law**

The laws in Ireland might be different from your country. For example, it is illegal to buy alcohol and tobacco if you're under 18 and the use of drugs is also illegal in Ireland. Smoking is not allowed inside public places (schools, workplaces, etc.). If in doubt, please speak to the Head of Student Services. If in doubt, please speak to the Head of Student Services.

Please note that if you break the school rules or the law, we may decide to remove you from the school, internship placement and your accommodation immediately and without a refund.

# YOUR PLACEMENT

Prior to arrival our placement team will place you in a field according to your preferences provided at the time of booking. If you have previously worked within the industry, you must be aware that you may not be undertaking the exact same tasks. The Internship is designed to provide you with experience of working in Ireland as well as practicing English and gaining new skills. We therefore encourage you to be open-minded and remember that **all experiences** can contribute to your personal development.

You will also be invited to an induction session, where the team will go through some important information. It is mandatory that you attend, as you will be provided with key information about your experience in Ireland.

Some students will be invited for a virtual interview, this will be an opportunity for your employer to meet you as well as an opportunity for you to ask any questions that you may have.

At the interview, please ask your manager for the dress code of the company. **REMEMBER-First impressions count!** 

While you are on placement, you **MUST INFORM** your company if you cannot go to work. Please call your company manager early in the morning or inform your placement officer. If you are not happy at your placement, please follow this procedure:

- Speak to your manager, try to resolve the problem by speaking to your manager in a professional way: describe the issue and the possible ways how it can be solved;
- 2 Inform your placement officer, if after speaking to your manager nothing improves, please arrange a time to come in to Twin to speak to your placement officer, or write your placement officer an email clearly stating the problem;
- 3 Your placement officer will contact the company; your placement officer will have to speak to your manager to try to resolve the situation.

If you are unhappy with your accommodation or placement in general, please contact Twin immediately at <a href="Internships@twingroup.org">Internships@twingroup.org</a>.

It is important that we know you are not happy so we can try to resolve the situation.

Some other recommendations from Twin are:

- Avoid using your phone when on placement, this is seen as a negative thing by managers, and if you need to
  use your phone, do this on breaks.
- Avoid mixing your personal time after work with work colleagues at your internship, this avoids any potential
  unnecessary situations that could affect your internship

During the duration of your placement, our placement team will contact you intermittently to check how your placement is progressing. As you will be at work, this will normally be done via email. Please do get back to us with an update! The first contact will be at the end of your first week. This will be your opportunity to let us know if we can improve your experience in anyway.

On the last Friday of your placement, we will invite you to an end of programme meeting. This will be your opportunity to provide us invaluable feedback regarding your experience as well as the collection of your certificate.

# **HEALTH & SAFETY INFORMATION**

#### **Doctor or Dentist**

- If you have the European Health Insurance Card you should be entitled to free or reduced health care.
- Please check with your parents or agent if you have Health Insurance and keep your Insurer's tel. number with you.
- Keep all receipts, maybe you will get your money back in your country
- Even if you get free dentist treatment in your own country, it is not free in Ireland. If you cannot wait to get treatment at home and you need urgent treatment, visit the emergency department of the nearest hospital or Walk in Clinic.
- Please contact a Twin member of staff if you have any questions regarding doctors/dentists

#### **Irish Law**

- **Alcohol** you need to be 18+ to buy and consume alcohol
- Tobacco legal age is also 18+ to buy tobacco.
   Fines up to €3,000 for smoking in buildings.
   Fines of up to €150 for throwing your cigarettes on the floor.
- Theft Irish shops are all supervised by CCTV cameras.

### Safety

- Don't leave your bags unattended even at work
- Don't carry large amounts of money
- Try not to walk alone late at night and stay with your friends
- Even if you are above 18 years old, we strongly recommend avoiding going out for drinks with your colleagues to avoid any incidents that could affect your internship
- If you are the victim of theft, report it immediately to the Police and then to Twin. If you feel
  you need support in reporting it to the police, you can contact Twin first and we can assist you.

# Mini Cabs/Taxi

- Take one if you are on your own at night
- We recommend you use the FreeNow application to book a taxi journey
- There are lots of illegal Minicabs around, pay attention! Do not get into a strangers' car if they are saying they are a taxi driver.

# LEAP CARDS FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORT

### Leap cards are valid for travel on:

- Airlink 747 & 757 airport bus services
- All Dublin Bus scheduled services (not valid on tours)
- All Luas (tram) services
- DART and Commuter Rail in the Short Hop Zone (all of Dublin city and county)

#### Points to note:

- Don't worry about fares or cash, simply touch your card against a Validator.
- On Dublin Bus, touch the card against the Leap Card Validator on the right-hand side as you enter the bus
- On Luas (tram), Touch On at a Validator on the platform before you get on the tram and Touch Off when you get off the tram.
- On DART and Commuter Rail, Touch On at the platform entry gate or Validator before your journey and Touch Off at the platform exit gate or Validator after your journey. The card can be used between stations within the Short Hop Zone.
- DO NOT LOSE YOUR LEAP CARD!!!
- Its your responsibility and if you lose it you will need to pay the replacement cost of €42 for a week.
