

Attachment A**Description of synthetic judgments for the assessment of learning in primary school**

Synthetic judgment	Description
Ottimo (excellent)	<p>The student carries out and completes the activities with autonomy and awareness, able to deal with complex and previously unproposed situations.</p> <p>Able to use his knowledge, skills and competences carry out tasks and solve problems constantly, even difficult tasks, in an original and personal way.</p> <p>Expresses himself correctly, with particular command of language, critical thinking and argumentation skills, appropriate to the context.</p>
Distinto (distinguished)	<p>The student carries out and completes activities with autonomy and awareness, managed to deal with complex situations.</p> <p>Able to use knowledge, skills and competences constantly carry out tasks and solve even difficult problems.</p> <p>Expresses himself correctly, with proper language and argumentation skills, appropriate to the context.</p>
Buono (good)	<p>The student carries out and completes the activities with autonomy and awareness.</p> <p>Able to use knowledge, skills and competences constantly perform tasks and solve problems.</p> <p>Expresses himself correctly, connecting the main information and using language appropriate to the context.</p>
Discreto (fair)	<p>The student carries out and completes the activities with partial autonomy and awareness.</p> <p>Able to use some knowledge, skills and competences to carry out tasks and solve not particularly complex problems.</p> <p>Able to expresses himself correctly, with simple vocabulary that is appropriate to the context.</p>
Sufficiente (sufficient)	<p>The student carries out the activities mainly under the guidance and with the support of the teacher.</p> <p>Able to apply some knowledge and skills to complete simple tasks and problems, only if the tasks are previously encountered.</p> <p>Expresses himself with a limited vocabulary and with some uncertainty.</p>
Non sufficiente (non sufficient)	<p>The student usually unable to carry out the proposed activities, even when guided by the teacher.</p> <p>Only occasionally applies knowledge and skills to perform a few simple tasks.</p> <p>Expresses himself with uncertainty and in a way that is not appropriate to the context.</p>
