A pass in an Advanced level subject is indicated by one of the grades A, B, C, D or E, of which grade A is the highest and grade E the lowest.

Special Paper Grades

The result in a Special Paper is shown by the words WITH DISTINCTION IN THE SPECIAL PAPER or WITH MERIT IN THE SPECIAL PAPER. The Special Paper result is shown on the line below the subject result.

ORDINARY LEVEL GRADINGS

Attainment in an Ordinary level subject is indicated by one of the grades A, B, C, D or E of which grade A is the highest and grade E the lowest. Candidates awarded grade A, B or C have reached the standard of the former subject pass at Ordinary level. Grade D indicates a lower level of attainment and grade E is the lowest level of attainment judged by the Syndicate to be of sufficient standard to be recorded. Performances below the standard of grade E are ungraded and not recorded on the certificate.

Grade O indicates an Ordinary level result awarded in a subject taken at Advanced level; the candidate did not pass at Advanced level but was judged to have reached at least the standard of grade C of the Ordinary level examination.

*Alternative Ordinary Subjects

The syllabus and examination in this subject were designed for candidates of greater maturity than is normally expected at Ordinary level.
